This ride offers cycling enthusiasts their choice of three routes: 33 miles, 66 miles or 100 mile century route. The ride offers full SAG support, police escort by Seminole & Volusia County Sheriff deputies, road marshals for riders to receive maintenance support along the route. There will be breakfast and lunch provided for all participants with veggie options and healthy carbs and drinks at all SAG stops. After the ride there will be a tent for VIP registered riders offering massage therapy, physical therapy and taping stations.
